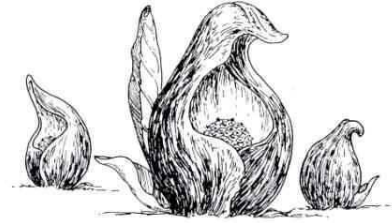


# FRIENDS OF LAKE WISSOTA STATE PARK MEETING AND ACTIVITY CALENDAR, 2018-19

April 10, Tuesday, 7 pm: Meeting, Park Office, LWSP. Open house, park jamboree and summer interpretive programs are on the agenda.

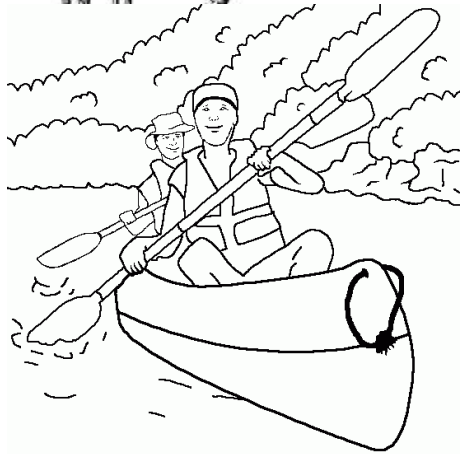

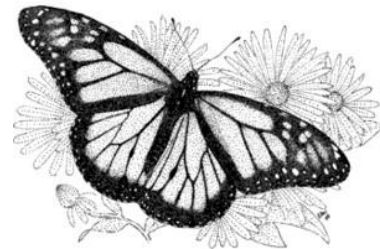
SKUNK CABBAGE

July 10, Tuesday, 7 pm, park office. Jamboree planning meeting. Also check what's happening in our beautiful butterfly garden!



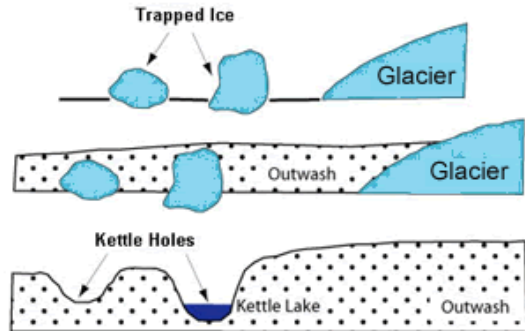


August 14, Tuesday, 6 pm: Prairie hike led by Rod Gont. Meet at prairie interpretive signs. Meeting at park office after hike.
